Review: One Size Pocket Diaper

Merry Fluffy Christmas starts tomorrow! The prize pack here at Happenings of the Harper Household is awesome filled with diapers and a wet bag with a value of over \$140.

Tonight I'm gonna tell you about Charlie Banana. Seriously, just the name Charlie Banana makes me smile, hehe.

And now a bit about the company...

Winc Design Limited is a Hong Kong-based company. Our team is an eclectic mix of Canadians, Americans, French, British, Nepalese and Chinese. We are proud of our global culture in our workforce.

After many years in the Toy and Juvenile industries, Gaëlle Wizenberg, president of Winc Design Limited, decided to create Charlie Banana®, a collection of baby and children's products that combine eco-friendliness, quality, and design in one brand. In creating Charlie Banana®, Gaëlle drew inspiration from her own two children: her son, Zachary, and her daughter, Charlie – or "Charlie Banana" as Zachary calls her. It's with great joy that Charlie Banana® comes to life.

We manufacture and distribute our own items so we can control everything from start to finish. Our base in Hong Kong places us next door to our manufacturers, allowing us to reduce our carbon footprint and shipping costs for our customers around the world.

Charlie Banana makes lots of [awesome products](#) including sized diapers, inserts, liners, disposable inserts, tote bags, hanging diaper pails, swim diapers, leg warmers, organic cotton underwear/training pants/boxers, nursing pads, feminine pads, and of course one size pocket diapers! Sugar received three one size pocket diapers to try out and let's just say I was impressed! The [one size pocket diapers](#) are available in a wide variety of

prints, solids, and fashion designs. Sugar received a hot pink diaper and 2 “goodbye disposable hello cloth” diapers.



The Charlie Banana One Size Diaper has a lot of great features. There are plenty of snaps to get a perfect fit around the waist as well as a hip snap to prevent wing droop. I really like the wide back elastic because not only does it make for a trimmer fit, but it holds the diaper securely against your little one. I remember using disposables with Dilly and she always had poop up her back because there was nothing to hold the diaper close to her – you will never have a poopy back with a Charlie Banana diaper! The elastic casing around the legs is wide which helps to prevent leaks from escaping there as well. Now when I first received our Charlie Banana diapers I was looking at them and thought “now how is this going to work there is no adjustment for the rise” which is what helps in making the leg openings smaller on most diapers. I will admit I used the diaper a few times and was having some leaking issues and then I figured it out. It was one of those moment that a light bulb goes off in your head. The leg elastic is also adjustable!! On each side of the diaper near where you stuff the insert you can see the elastic and it attaches with a button. You simply adjust it to fit your little one perfectly – just like adjustable waist pants! And I have to say I like this SO much better than rise snaps. It seems that when Sugar gets really active I will hear a rise snap pop and I just know there will be leaking – I don’t have to worry about this with the Charlie Banana diapers. Plus the diaper just looks simpler without a billion snaps on the front which would be a super positive feature considering grandparents or babysitter that might be intimidated by cloth diapers. The only suggestion I have is making this feature a bit more obvious on the website.



I also love that this is a hybrid diaper meaning it can be used with reusable inserts or with disposable inserts. We have only used our Charlie Banana's with the reusable inserts – which they come with TWO – but I love that there is this option. It would be perfect for sending to day care or for babysitters or even when vacationing.



Place one or two reusable inserts inside the flap opening and tuck it in nicely. Because our flap is at the front, it is easy to readjust your diaper.



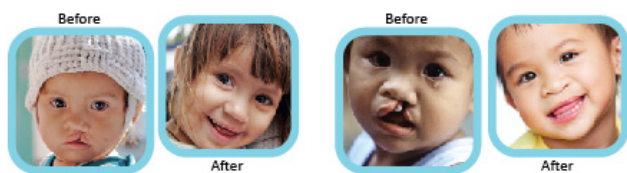
Place one disposable insert on top of the fleece and secure it into the front flap. This will secure the disposable insert.

And seriously... how cute does Sugar look!

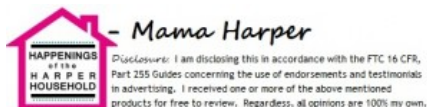
