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Charlie Banana Cloth Diaper Review & Giveaway

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One of the items in my swag bag at the HauteGreen party in San Diego at BlogHer11 was a diaper from a company I had never heard of before. I have found that this is the best way for me to try new things because I become brand loyal so easily...giving me something for free definitely lets me stretch my wings a little to try new things.



Charlie Banana is the name of the company...and the diaper they gave us is their adorable [“Goodbye Disposable, Hello Cloth” diaper](#). Currently out of stock and coveted by many, I feel very lucky to have received this diaper. In fact, if you know a retailer that has them in stock, please comment with their link.

The Goodbye Disposable, Hello Cloth diaper is a 2 in 1 system. What that means is that it can be used



either as a hybrid diaper or as a pocket diaper. To use it as a hybrid diaper, a disposable insert is placed inside the diaper, but not inside the pocket. This makes for easy changes when out and about, and the cover can be reused if not soiled. To use it as a pocket diaper, which is how I used it, you can stuff it with one or two of the inserts that are included. My husband was going to be taking Quinn out on a semi long trip, so I stuffed it with both inserts. When they came back a couple hours later, he hadn't leaked at all, which was great!



As for sizing of this diaper, it is considered a one size diaper. It will fit from birth until potty training. The fit is determined by the snaps and also there is hidden adjustable elastic inside the gussets. The great thing about this elastic is it takes the guesswork out of what size you're going for. There's no confusing numbers...or worse, lack of numbers. The holes are simply labeled with their corresponding size. How easy is that? As you can see in the picture, the sizes are further adjustable for that perfect fit. Quinn, my 33" and 23lb toddler was wearing this on the lowest setting of size Large, according to the elastic. I could have made it tighter still and he would have been comfortable. By the way, please ignore my gnarly thumb... I had a watermelon cutting accident as a teenager and it's never looked the same since 😊

Probably the best thing about this diaper is what's on the backside. Check it out!
