We love bumGenius! They were recommended to me by a friend, and I went ahead and bought a whole stash of the 4.0s before my little guy was born. We are almost 7 months into this parenting (and cloth diapering) gig, and we are still loving them! My only real complaint is that they are terribly bulky under clothing, especially with the doubler/newborn insert I have to use in addition to the regular insert (little man is a heavy wetter). We've only had a couple of leak incidents, and that's usually when the diaper had shifted a bit or he slept a super long time through the night. Thanks for this post too! I was already thinking about buying a few of the other brands of diapers, and this is helping me narrow down my choices!

I love that one too but the Basix is a smidge smaller and for now, fits my baby better (I have the sized versions) and the microfleece lining is SO soft! I also like the GoGreen Champ and have discovered an awesome new diaper, Booty Buns.
